





PROTECTION SCHEME

The Pineapple Virus Protection Scheme has been running now since viruses first started becoming a problem on Archimedes computers nearly 18 months ago.

Based on software originally written by Acorn, the protection works in two ways. A small module (VProtect) is automatically loaded whenever the computer is switched on or reset. This provides a warning message if any infected software is run or if any virus attempts to infect the computer. A major application (!Killer) is also provided, which is capable of scanning any filing system or device, including all types of hard disc, floppies, networks and even CD -ROMs. All types of compressed file are catered for and any viruses found can be removed easily without the need to delete infected files.





HOW TO GET THE MOST FROM YOUR PRINTER

Version 1.22 of the !Printers application has now been released, and includes an expanded range of definition files for driving a wider range of printers. It is now possible to print 'in the background', ie transparently to other tasks, and to allow a given printer to be used by all the computers connected to an Acorn Access network.

The !Printers application is loaded as normal by double-clicking on the !Printers icon in the directory window. The application is set up by loading one or more Printer Definition Files applicable to the printers available; this is achieved by choosing the Printer Control option from the application icon bar menu, and dragging the relevant definition file into the printer control window which appears. Further configuration options (such as print quality, paper feed type etc) may be set by highlighting the line describing the relevant printer in the printer control window, and choosing the Configure option from the menu associated with the window. The Connection option, available on the same menu, produces a dialogue box which allows you to set !Printers up for use with a printer connected to the Parallel port, the Serial port, or a remote printer connected via Econet or Ethernet NFS. In addition, the Connections dialogue box allows you to save data which would be output via the printer to a disc file instead, and it is this dialogue box which contains the action button to enable background printing.

Information concerning which Printer Definition File to use with which printer is contained in a number of text files throughout the !Printers directory structure.

MONITORS AND MODES

It is possible to connect a wide range of monitors to Archimedes computers equipped with RISC OS 3.1; however, only a subset of the total number of screen modes will be available on VGA, SVGA and TV scan rate monitors. Acorn's own multiscan monitors (the AKF50 and AKF52) can display all screen modes except Mode 23, which is specifically designed for use with very high-resolution mono monitors.

Monitors with a 15 pin VGA style connector can be connected to an older Acorn computer's 9 pin output using a suitable adaptor available via your Acorn dealer.

After a power-on or machine reboot, your machine performs the Power-On Self Test (POST), which includes a complete memory and video test. To reduce the time between reset and the Desktop appearing, you can disable the VIDC check and the long RAM test by setting bit 7 of byte 188 (& BC) in CMOS RAM. This can be done with a basic program:

SYS 6,161,188 TO ,,A% :REM read the value SYS 6, 162,188, (A% OR 1<<7) :REM write it back with bit 7 set
