## Key Features

- 1. Termulator is a ROM which enables the BBC Microcomputer to emulate a variety of different computer terminals.
- 2. Emulations provided are ANSI (VT100); VT52; Tektronix 4010; 'glass Teletype'; a 'hardcopy' terminal, and a special 'BBC terminal' which enables the host computer output to be sent directly to the BBC Microcomputer's VDU driver.
- 3. With Temulator it is possible to use the BBC Microcomputer as a terminal for almost any mainframe computer or computer network.
- 4. It is not necessary for the user to be familiar with the BBC Microcomputer in order to use Termulator and a comprehensive user guide is included in the pack.
