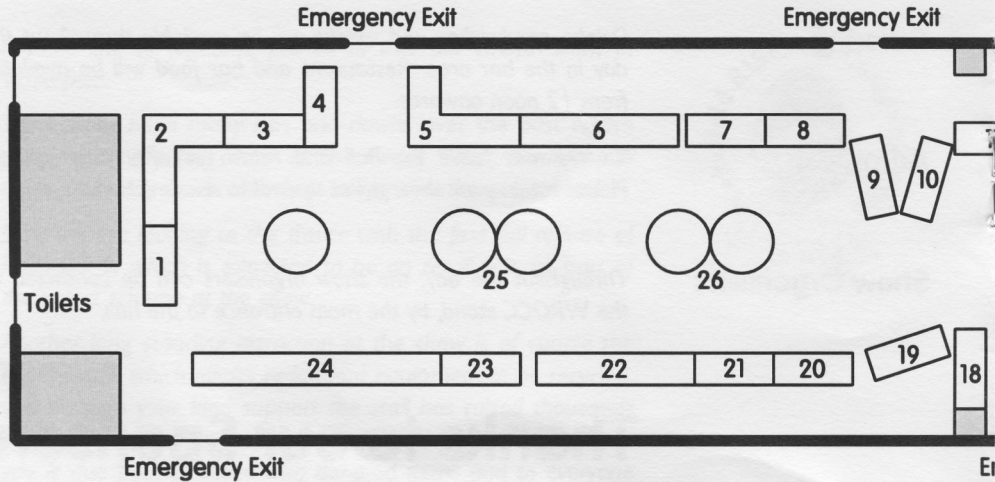

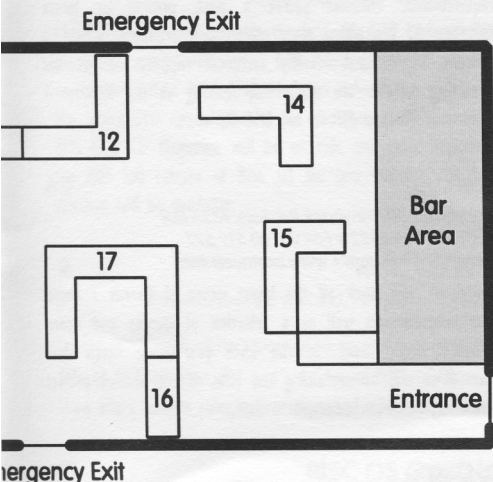

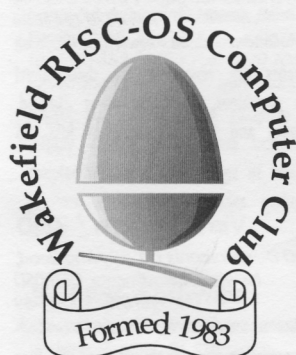
The Wakefield RISC OS Computer Club was formed in 1983, and is one of the longest running local RISC OS user groups in the UK.
