

Scan-Light and Scan-Light Junior

here are two versions available: the original Scan-Light, which is a full A4 width 200 dpi hand-held scanner and Scan-Light Junior which is a half width (up to) 400 dpi hand-held scanner. Both versions include an interface board that plugs inside the computer.

Both versions come with the same software provided in ROM on the interface board. This means instant loading and no messing with discs the software is always instantly available.

Scan-Light can be used to input graphics from sources such as photographs, diagrams or drawings into a variety of Archimedes programs. Ideal for DTP programs such as Acorn DTP or Impression and the !Paint and !Draw programs provided with the Archimedes. Indeed pictures captured with Scan-Light can be further manipulated or edited in a variety of ways by both these programs.

Scan-Light finally allows the Archimedes to handle graphics with the same ease as it handles text.

The software is WIMP based and easy to use and fully RISC-OS compatible. It includes the following features:

- The ability to view the current scanned image within a window on the desktop, which can be scrolled and re-sized.
- Zoom option allows the scanned image to be scaled to any size from 1% to 999% of original.
- Pixel editing facilities operate at all scales.
- Printer drivers for a variety of dotmatrix, ink-jet and laser printers.
- Two scanning modes; one for halftone pictures and photographs and one for monochrome images such as line drawings and text.

his is a new Archimedes version of our very popular spreadsheet package for the BBC Micro. Using our advanced cross-processor compiler technology, we have converted the program so that it now runs as an ARM assembly language program. This provides two main advantages—it no longer needs the 6502 emulator, and all operations are faster; indeed most operations are between 300% and 400% faster than the previous version.

What is more, this version has been altered to take advantage of Archimedes features such as new screen modes, and will operate in the new extra-wide screen modes (132 columns) and the multi-sync mode 18 offering 80 columns by 64 lines on screen—ideal for the larger spreadsheets.

B ased on INTER-CHART for the BBC, this slightly enhanced version runs under the 6502 emulator. It offers a range of chart and graph plotting facilities.

Its features include:

- Plots a variety of bar charts, line graphs and pie charts.
- Data can be input either direct at the keyboard or from file.
- Data for up to 16 graphs in memory at once.
- Automatic or manual labelling textmay be added to any position on the graph.
- Automatic axis scaling and log or lin scale on both or either axis.
- Uses extended Archimedes screen modes and colours.

Fax Pack

This much delayed expansion board is still undergoing development. It basically consists of a 9600 bps modern that will offer full FAX functions to the Archimedes computer in addition to fast file transfer. Approximate release schedule—third quarter 1990.

Concept Laser

An expansion board that drives lowcost laser printer engines. Using the Archimedes RISC processor to create the high-resolution image avoids much of the electronics and bottlenecks in traditional laser printers, so offering low cost and high performance laser printing to all RISC OS programs. Release schedule second quarter 1990.

Desktop II

This consists of two disc based programs. One replaces the existing Acorn desktop filer (all windows showing disc files are controlled by the filer) and offers numerous new features and extensions over the existing filer. For example, date and time stamping of files, advanced file finders (given a file name it searches all directories) new file display options etc. Secondly a 'Mac like' desktop program offers the ability to place file and directory icons anywhere on the desktop, allowing much simpler access to commonly used files and directories. Expected release first quarter 1990.

FastDraw

A brand new drawing program specifically designed for 1Mbyte Archimedes. This is functionally similar to, and completely compatible with, the Acorn !Draw program and so offers basically the same set of features. However the FastDraw program, because it is written in ARM assembler, is TEN TIMES SMALLER and faster than the

equivalent Acorn offering. Now at last 1Mbyte machine owners can take advantage of the unique RISC OS multi-tasking. Ideally suited to programs such as Impression or Paint since it allows this complete drawing program to operate at the same time, and integrate with other RISC OS programs on a 1Mbyte machine. Expected release first quarter 1990.
